legal capacity for all: including older persons in the ... - permit the deprivation of legal decision-making rights on the grounds that an individual's decision-making skills are impaired). legal capacity is the ability to hold rights and duties (legal standing) and to exercise those rights and duties (legal agency). it is the key to accessing meaningful participation in society.

decisional capacity - university of washington - increasing age and cognitive impairment are associated with lack of decisional capacity. surprisingly, however, psychiatric illness does not correlate with lack of decisional capacity. 2 other studies have shown that patients with schizophrenia are more likely to lack decision-making capacity than those with depression.
